


Greenland vs Iceland



Think about the two words ICELAND and GREENLAND. Make a web or thought shower of all the words that spring to mind.





Where is Greenland ?

Greenland is at the Northern Europe in the Kingdom of Denmark.

- Greenland is almost entirely covered by an ice cap.
- The entire coastline of Greenland is jagged and dotted with deeply carved enormous glaciers.
- Greenland is the most scattered populated country on earth.
- There are no roads connecting different towns in Greenland, only 60km of roads within the towns themselves!
- The national Greenlandic dish is a soup made of seal, whale, deer or seabird meat.
- Greenland is one of the best spots in the world to see the Northern Lights in winter.




Volcanoes!

The flag!

The flag of Greenland was designed by a local artist. The white is a symbol of the ice and snow that covers most of the island, and the red is a symbol of the sun.

Similarities

- Both country's main religion is Christian.

- Iceland has a good road network, Greenland doesn't.
- Winter temperatures are different, much colder in Greenland.
- It is much wetter in Iceland.


