- Repeat this for the Year 3-4 Spelling 2 and Missing Word Sentences 2.



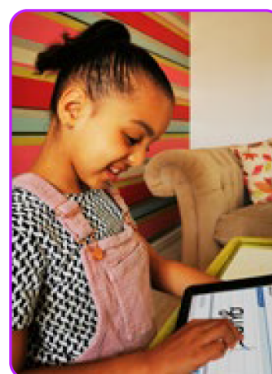
